Place game

Any number of people can play this game. And you do not even need any material for this. Just think of a place (country, city, town etc.) that begins with the letter 'a'. The next person has to think with the name of a place that begins with the last alphabet of the first country and so on. If you can't think of a name you get kicked out of the game. The last person left is the winner!

Draw and tell

This is one of the best activities to help children listen, read, understand, draw and color all in one activity. You will need some crayons, markers, pencils and one storybook. One person is chosen to read the storybook and the other children have to draw what the story is about. The children can take turns and by the time the story has ended you have a story book that you can staple and use later!

Making your own encyclopedia

Children can make their own fun books about anything they want. One idea is to make an encyclopedia about animals. Ask your children to collect pictures of animals and birds. They can use old newspapers, magazines and other places to look for their pictures. Help your children cut out the pictures and paste them in a blank journal. Help them find information on the animals, what they eat, where they live and how they survive in the wild.
